

COMMON ASKED QUESTIONS ON MINI-FACE LIFTS

How long will the facelift last?

They normally last five to ten years with an average of seven years.

2. Will I have any bruising?

85% of our patients have no bruising. If there is bruising it will last seven to ten days.

3. Will I have any swelling?

Yes, almost every patient will experience swelling around the 3rd to 4th day. Swelling is a temporary side effect and will not affect your results.

4. How much time will I have to take off work?

Most patients can go back to work within two to three days. If there is bruising it could last seven to ten days.

5. When will my stitches be removed?

Sutures are removed in one week.

6. Will I be in any pain?

Most of our patients have very little discomfort. You will be given a script for pain medication if pain should occur.

7. Will I have any scarring?

The area where the incision is made will fade over time and will be unnoticeable.

8. Where is the incision site?

The incision site is in the ear and goes slightly into the hairline.

9. Is the doctor Board Certified?

Dr. Seiger is a board-certified dermatologist and a cosmetic surgeon. There is no Board Certification for cosmetic surgeons.

10. Why do we have such a low price?

We originally decided to cut our prices in half due to the economy. However, we wanted to make things possible and affordable for people who have always wanted cosmetic procedures and could not afford them. Dr. Seiger would love for all his patients to get what they need to make them feel youthful and confident.

11. When can I dye my hair?

After sutures are removed, this is in one week.

12. When can I start exercising?

Moderate exercise like walking is acceptable. Avoid any strenuous exercise until your sutures are removed.

13. When can I wash my hair?

You can wash your hair the very next day after your procedure. Remove all bandages, get in the shower, shampoo your hair and wash your incision sites thoroughly. After showering, apply Vaseline to your incision sites.

14. When can I put on make-up?

After sutures are removed, this is in one week. You may wear make-up in areas where there are no sutures. Be careful to avoid your incision area

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
